TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

- Only two of each species may be hunted per hunter except for leopard = one only.
- Leopard bait is plains game and is charged as per the plains game price list, bait animal trophies are exportable.
- Wounded animals paid for in full.
- Day fees payable in full when you book to confirm dates and quota allocation.
- Trophy fee deposit for key species/booked species to be paid by bank transfer no later than 21 days before the hunt.
- Any additional animals hunted can be paid for in cash at the end of the hunt.
- Hunting season is February to November.
- No credit card facilities available.

DAILY RATES INCLUDE

- Premium class accommodation.
- Services of trained camp staff including: supervisors, cooks, trackers and skinners.
- Licensed Professional Hunters.
- 4 wheel drive vehicles in the hunting area.
- Daily cleaning and laundry services.
- All meals, snacks, and soft drinks.
- Field preparation and salting of trophies.
- Wi-Fi in camp.

DAILY RATES DOES NOT INCLUDE

- Hotel accommodation before, during or after the safari.
- Aircraft charters, Commercial flights, Visas and airport taxes.
- Vehicle rental other than those used in the safari area and airport transfer.
- Dip and pack Taxidermy fees or export of trophies.
- Alcoholic beverages.
